Studies show that when children are not engaged in thinking and learning activities over the summer, they show little or no academic growth. Typically, studies have documented that students will lose 1-3 mo. of learning due to lack of mental stimulation over the summer. The Academy's programs provide lots of opportunities for student learning and will offset the summer "brain drain". Students attend twice weekly for a three-week session. (Mon/Wed OR Tues/Thurs).

Please remember private tutorials can be scheduled at any time throughout the summer and do not follow the session calendar. Tutorials can also be rolled over to the following session if students have vacation conflicts.

During the summer, new tutorials meet twice weekly for a minimum of 6 class periods. We recognize "excused absences" in the summer; however, arrangements must be made in advance, through the office, and have the approval of the Director. Unless this procedure is followed, parents will be charged the regular class or tutorial rate as our teachers are on contracts; therefore, we must meet our financial obligations to our staff.

As you consider summer learning options for your child, remember summer is a great way to "catch up" from the Covid slide. We will be offering programs in math, reading, Study Skills, and SAT/ACT prep. We find juniors and seniors often benefit from a summer college prep class as they do not have to deal with the busy schedules and demands of the academic year. Furthermore, students will receive their test results far in advance of early application deadlines. If you are dissatisfied with your August scores, you can always retake the test during the academic year. Take advantage of this opportunity to reach your peak score by participating in our SAT/ACT prep programs this summer.

If you are considering a tutorial for the summer session, you should complete the appropriate registration form and forward it with your tuition payment in order to secure placement with the teacher or class of your choice. Once again, we welcome the opportunity to work with your son or daughter.
