Subject: Summer Tutorial Sessions

Summer will soon be here, and now is the time to consider providing academic maintenance and acceleration to avoid any slippage during the summer. The Academy's summer program provides a great opportunity to explore new concepts, maintain the gains with skills taught previously, experience enrichment activities, or receive academic support. We hope you will consider one of our private tutorials and allow your son/daughter to get excited about learning this summer.

Studies show that when children are not engaged in thinking and learning activities over the summer, they show little or no academic growth. Typically, studies have documented that students will lose 1-3 months of learning due to a lack of mental stimulation over the summer. The Academy's programs provide lots of opportunities for student learning and will offset the summer "brain drain". Our math and reading programs (K-12) provide an excellent opportunity for reinforcement and enrichment. Please refer to the website for all tutorial options.

Private tutorials can be scheduled at any time throughout the summer and do not necessarily need to follow the session calendar. If you have vacation plans or camps scheduled, please document the times on the registration form. We can roll over any interruptions and credit classes upon his/her return.

The Academy's summer programs are scheduled as follows;

SESSION I	June 16 th – July 3 rd (Make-ups scheduled for holiday)
SESSION II	July 7 th - July 25 th
SESSION III	July 28 th - August 15 th

*Students attend twice weekly for a three-week session (Mon/Wed) or (Tues/Thurs).

*Scheduling is flexible during the summer due to camps, vacations, etc., and students need not follow the session dates.

Although the Academy officially closed its primary location at 400 Cochran Road, many of our teachers are still available throughout the summer for private tutoring. Parents can contact them directly and make scheduling arrangements and payments with the individual tutor of their choice. (See website for more information.)
